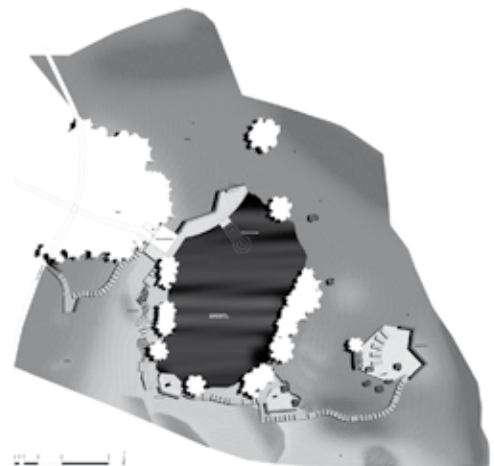
KNEIPP FACILITIES SCHWANDALPWEIHER

When the Entlebuch region was awarded the status of UNESCO Biosphere Reservation, the Flühli-Wasser cooperative was looking for opportunities to expand their tourist attractions by using the natural beauty of the region. This prompted the construction of the Kneipp Facilities. A "health trail" can be followed barefoot on a path made entirely from wood. The premises consist of stairs and platforms; on each platform, the visitors are subtly stimulated by water features and the contrast of wood and stone. The path ends in a terrace on the lake, where visitors can stretch out on comfortable wood loungers.
